## **Introduction**

The AYSO Region 213 recreational Spring Soccer is a child focused program which delivers a **FUN** and **EDUCATIONAL** program for youth soccer players. We are a soccer organization with **HAPPY**, **HEALTHY** kids where every girl or boy stepping on a soccer field for the first time can have fun and learn something.

The AYSO Region 213 child-first approach makes it one of the finest **PLAYER DEVELOPMENT** programs where developing the child is fundamental in AYSO Region 213.

AYSO Region 213's trained and certified volunteer coaches use soccer to expand a child's natural joy for running and kicking by adding techniques for controlling the ball, teaching kids to work as a team, encouraging creative decision making and strategic thinking.

Soccer is a fast game that keeps players moving the entire time. The small-sided game format is like "street soccer" – children of many skill levels choose up teams and play together for a fun, neighborhood game. And, unlike other programs, AYSO Region 213's neighborhood approach allows you to play with your neighborhood and school friends.

## Information

AYSO Region 213 offers recreational<sup>1</sup> Spring Soccer for the following divisions<sup>2</sup>

<u>Division</u>	<u>Birthday Range</u>
Under-6:	August 1, 2003 – July 31, 2005
Under-8	August 1, 2001 – July 31, 2003
Under-10	August 1, 1999 – July 31, 2000

Recreational teams are formed in late February. And, the season starts March 6, 2010 and runs through May. **YES**, Spring Season does clash with other Spring Sports. Games are played on Saturday and practices are held during daylight hours during the week.

## Registration Instructions

If your son or daughter **did not** play the Fall 2009 Season in Region 213, then (to register):

1. Go to [www.eAYSO.org](http://www.eAYSO.org) and create a login.
2. Completely fill out a Player Pre-registration form and print out two (2) copies.
3. Sign and initial both copies.
4. If your child is playing AYSO soccer for the first time, then include a copy of a government issued proof of their date of birth (such as a birth certificate or passport).
5. Include a check for \$110 payable to 'AYSO Region 213', and
6. Mail it to the address below.

If your son or daughter **did** play the Fall 2009 Season in Region 213, then (to register):

1. Login on [www.eAYSO.org](http://www.eAYSO.org).
2. Select 'Print Player Form' and print out one (1) copy of their Player Registration form.
3. Sign and initial the Player Registration form.
4. Include a check for \$65 payable to 'AYSO Region 213', and
5. Mail it to the address below.
